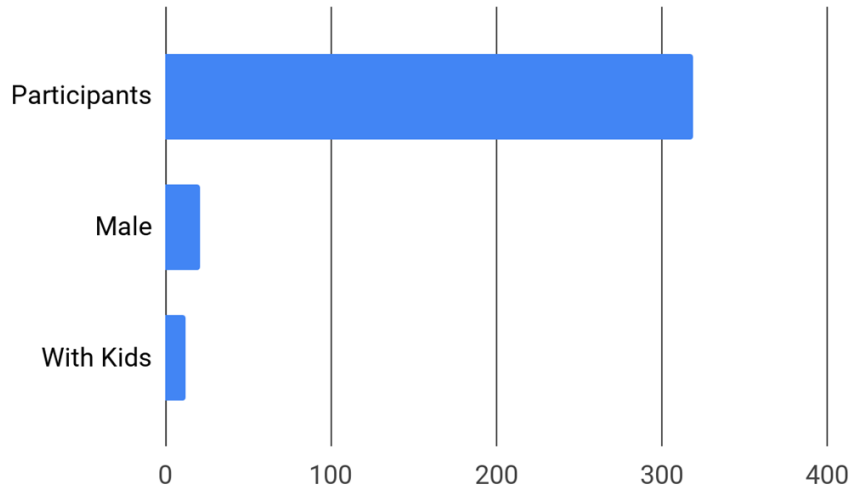

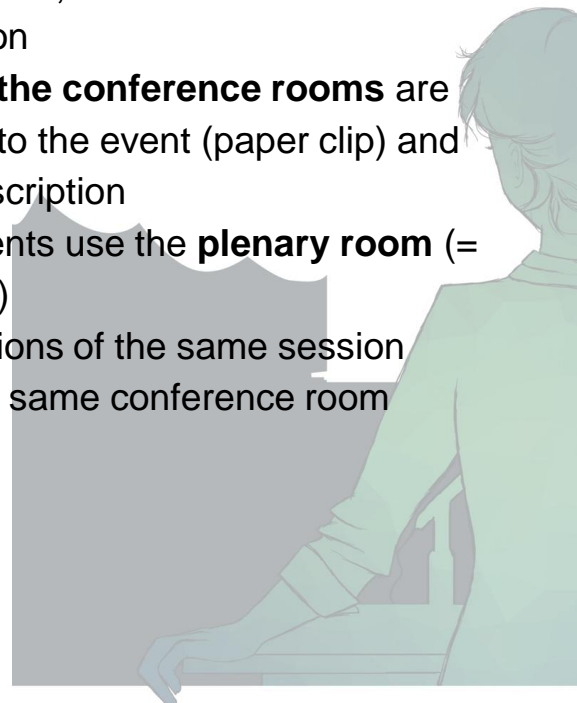




Slack Chat

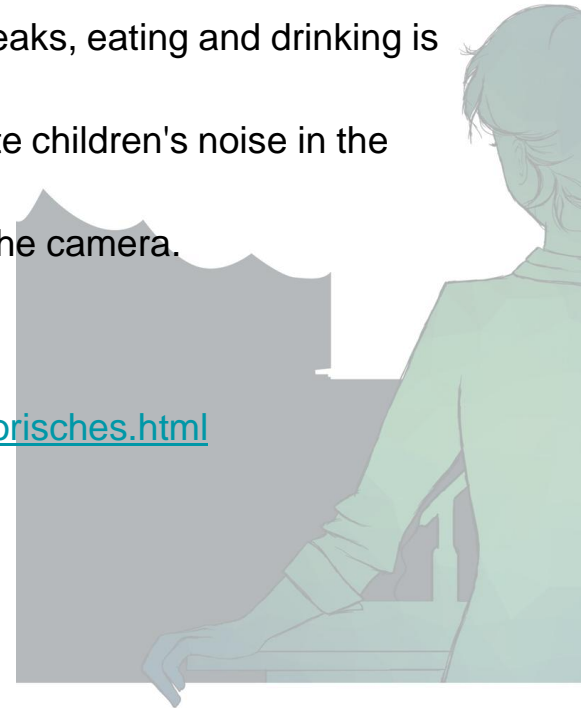


Good Online Conference Practice
